

What results does Torah Ohr anticipate for the students?

1. Love of the LORD GOD, love of Torah, and love of the Jewish people.
2. Purging from the "dust" of idolatry - expressed one way or another in thoughts, words and deeds.
3. Purging from prejudices against, and stereotypes formed about, the teachings of the righteous of Israel. Specifically prejudices arising from "automatic thought patterns," "rational doctrines," or theological anti-Semitism, idolatry and \ or Hellenism.
4. Purifying of the thoughts
5. Recognition of Jewish/Torah thought.
6. Connection to the true *tzaddikim* (righteous individuals) in each and every generation who rose up from the Jewish people, who are the richness of the world.
7. Development of the ability to hear, observe and interpret the Scriptures, and introduce new insights that will cause our faith to grow.
8. Character refinement.
9. Building Integrity: What we think is what we say and is what we do in relation to the word of God.
10. Dissemination of the learning: personal involvement by concrete actions of the students, writing and publicizing the messages and lessons learned, for the LORD's sake, for the sake of all those belonging to Him in truth, and for the sake of the entire world.
