

other; and there you will serve other gods, which neither you nor your fathers have known, wood and stone" [Deu 28:64].

God did not and will not forsake His people Israel, because: *"the Strength (in Hebrew: **the immortality**) of Israel will not lie..." [1Sa 15:29]. That "If [any] of yours be driven out unto the outmost [parts] of heaven, from there will the LORD thy God gather you (Israel), and from there will he bring you." [Deu 30:4]. And now, pay close attention to the following words, and ponder them in the depths of your heart:*

"For ask now regarding the early days that were before you, since the day that God created man upon the earth, and from one end of the heavens to the other end of the heavens, whether there was anything like this great thing, or was the likes of it heard? Did ever a people hear God's voice speaking out of the midst of the fire as you (Israel) have heard, and live? Or has any god performed miracles to come and take him a nation from the midst of another nation, with trials, with signs, and with wonders, and with war and with a strong hand, and with an outstretched arm, and with great awesome deeds, as all that the Lord your God did for you in Egypt before your eyes? You have been shown, in order to know that the Lord He is God; there is none else besides Him. From the heavens, He let you hear His voice to instruct you, and upon the earth He showed you His great fire, and you heard His words out of the midst of the fire, and because He loved your forefathers and chose their seed after them, and He brought you out of Egypt before Him with His great strength..." [Deu 4:32-39]

We must understand the following rule which is critical to our faith: God did not override the natural order of the world at Mount Sinai - to turn around and exchange His Torah or His people - and scatter the secrets of His kingdom to strangers who would defile the holy.

Understand: The Torah, which is the fountain of eternal life, includes the mitzvot which are God's will. And although the Torah is the Book of Commandments, ultimately, there is not even one single commandment which includes instructions on how to fulfill it.

if God chose the People of Israel as His Am Segula (*typically translated as "chosen people," but the Hebrew also connotes "medicine" and "healing"—eternally), and if He gave the Torah to the People of Israel, then He certainly
